- Lifeguard 1 applicants <u>will</u> have the American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certificate before employment begins in May 2023.
- Hourly City Worker/Lifeguard Trainee applicants will not have an American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certificate before employment begins in May 2023.

If an Hourly City Worker/LG trainee is hired, they will go through the City of Glendale's training program which includes the American Red Cross Lifeguard Training program. Upon completion, trainees will be promoted to a Lifeguard I positon.

If your application is accepted and you are offered a position, YOU WILL RECEIVE AN EMAIL requesting that you to fill out and submit a conviction history questionnaire form.
